Gabriel Pawlik at Forza 9 Gallery, 7, 8, 9th September, 2007

Gabriel Pawlik presents a selection of his latest work in Forza 9 Gallery, Polis Chrysochous. The opening of the exhibition will take place on Friday 7th September at 9pm and will run until Sunday evening. The exhibition combines mosaics and ceramic objects. The mosaics are made of glass, tiles and pebbles and show the diversity of techniques and subjects which occupied the artist during the last couple of years. The ceramic objects were created only recently after Pawlik moved to Cyprus permanently. These ceramics represent the artist's interest in mythology and collective unconsciousness (C. G. Jung) in particular and archaic expressions in general. Gabriel Pawlik was born in 1954 in Germany and has lived in Goudi, Cyprus for a year. He studied Design, History of Art, Ceramics and Sculpting, Theology and Psychological Art Therapy. He worked, among others, at archaeological excavations, as designer, as art therapist and as an artist specialising in mosaics and ceramics. His passion is the relationship between Art, Religion, Mythology and Psychology.
